

Zetron Successfully Demo's Live with 5 P25 Networks

Live demonstrations of Zetron's P25-compliant Advanced Communications (Acom EVO) system working with five major radio manufacturers' P25-compliant radio networks were featured at the Project 25 Technology Interest Group (PTIG) booth at IWCE.

Redmond, WA, U.S.A., March 28, 2013 –Zetron, a leading provider of mission-critical solutions worldwide, successfully demonstrated its Advanced Communications (Acom EVO) system operating live with five major radio manufacturers' networks in the Project 25 Technology Interest Group (PTIG) booth at the International Wireless Communication Expo (IWCE) in Las Vegas, Nevada, March 13-14, 2013. The demonstrations illustrated the seamless interoperation that can result between a console system and radio network that are both utilizing P25-compliant interfaces.



Acom EVO utilizing the TIA P25 Digital Fixed Station Interface (DFSI) was demonstrated live with Tait, Codan Radio Communications, and Simoco conventional radio networks. Acom EVO utilizing the TIA Project 25 (P25) Console Subsystem Interface (CSSI) was demonstrated live with Cassidian, Tait and Motorola trunked radio networks. The DFSI allows a direct connection between the console system and conventional base and repeater stations. The CSSI connects the console to the switch network (RF SubSystem [RFSS]) of a trunking or large conventional system.

"These demonstrations gave customers a glimpse into the expanded range of choices they have when different manufacturers utilize open standards," said Zetron president and CEO, Ellen O'Hara. "The demonstrations also allowed customers to see for themselves the increasing number of P25 networks Zetron console solutions now interface with, as well as the inherent interoperability, flexibility and compatibility these solutions offer."
